

THE PIA AWARD FOR ARCHITECTURE 2023 AND THE SOUTH AFRICAN INSTITUTE OF ARCHITECTS AWARD OF MERIT & AWARD FOR EXCELLENCE 2023/24 TO BE CONFIRMED BY SAIA

CONDITIONS FOR ENTRY: CAT B - RESEARCH OR WORK OF SOCIAL IMPORTANCE

- Any member of the PIA or any of the SAIA Regional Institutes may submit work. More than one work may be submitted.
- The regional panel of adjudicators appointed by the PIA Events Committee for Category B: Chris Malan (Convener), Prof Gerald Steyn (Architect + Academic), Prof Nico Botes(Academic). Mauneen van Wyk (Facilitator and Administrator). The panel will adjudicate all entries and recommend to the committee which should be awarded the regional awards, and submit the research or work of social importance for national assessment. Having made its decision by the end of July 2023, the regional committee will prepare the adjudicators' report and regional citations, and arrange for the notification, receipt and forwarding of any additional documentation that may be required for national assessment by the due date.
- Nominations must be made on the attached nomination/submission form (Entry Form B). A separate form must be used for each nomination/submission.
- Nomination/Submission forms for research or work of social importance must be accompanied by the following:
 - A non-refundable entry fee of R650.00 including VAT to assist in defraying 1 costs. This payment needs to be made prior to submission. All proof of payments need to be uploaded before any entry will be accepted.
 - 2. An A4 brochure uploaded in PDF:
 - A copy of the submission form.
 - A brief description of the research or work of approximately 300 words by ii. the author. A one sentence summary of the work and its importance should
 - iii. A brief comment on the research or work not exceeding 300 words from the academic promoter or client.
 - Consent for the work from the promoter / client to be entered into the iv.
 - A copy of the full documentation (research or work of social importance). ٧.
- Only members of the recognised SAIA Regional Institutes are eligible to make submissions for these awards.
- SAIA Awards for research or a work of social importance:
 - A submission will be considered eligible for entry in the SAIA awards if the member is enrolled as a SAIA member. The recipient/s of the award at the awards ceremony must be a member of SAIA in his/her individual capacity. Entries should identify clearly whether the entry also meets the requirements for consideration of a SAIA award.
 - 2. If the research or work is submitted for national adjudication, the regional committee will notify the member/s timeously. For the national adjudication, exhibition and record purposes, the following documentation must be submitted to SAIA by a date and format still to be confirmed.
 - i. 6 copies of the A4 brochure (or A3 folded to A4) containing all the information described above under 4 - 2. All documents must be of A4 size or A3 folded to A4 size.
 - ii. 2 sets of maximum 2 different posters per project of A1 laminated posters containing a summary of the work, suitably illustrated with charts and images and bearing the name of the author/s, the name of the academic promoter or client and the title and descriptive synopsis of the research or work (refer proforma poster layout).
 - iii. 6 electronic copies on DVD of the submission, comprising:

- All individual images (JPG / PDF) of suitable resolution for publication (min 300 dpi at A4 size)
- Full electronic copy in PDF of the research or work of social importance. Or, five copies of the work if it is in book form.

NOTE: Disk to be clearly marked.

The above documentation will not to be returned by SAIA.

 The research or work of social importance which has received a regional Award for Architecture in 2023 and also meets SAIA's eligibility requirements must be submitted for consideration for the SAIA national awards; the Award of Merit and the Award for Excellence. Authors of the awarded research or work and the academic promoter or client/s must agree to this condition.

Digital Submissions must be uploaded and finalised by no later than end of day 19 May 2023. If printed material needs to be submitted, it should reach the Pretoria Institute for Architecture at 273 Tram Street, Nieuw Muckleneuk, Pretoria by not later than **12 noon 19 May 2023.**
